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## **Examination of Scriptural Inerrancy:** A Computer Analysis of the Torah

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When Galileo improved <u>Hans Lippershey</u>'s 1608-invention of the telescope in 1609, it is reported that Aristotelian philosophers and defenders of the Vatican—Cesar Cremonini (1550-1631), Giulio Libri, and others—refused to look through it lest what they saw did not agree with what they believed. Galileo was also accused of modifying his telescope so that people would see what he wanted them to see. Shortly after Giulio Libri's death, Galileo wrote,

"...never having wanted to see [the Medicean Stars (Moons of Jupiter)] on Earth, perhaps he'll see them on the way to heaven?" [Galileo's letter to Welser of 17 Dec 1610, in Opere, XI, 14], quoted by Robert Currey in "Philosophers who refused to look through Galileo's Telescope"

Rather than planets, we are speaking here about 3500-year-old words. Today computers instead of telescopes have become the 21<sup>st</sup> Century enemy of all American religious denominations. Computers expose the academic fraud that the Torah—the first five books of the Bible written by Moses—are inaccurate and corrupt. They have replaced faith in the Torah—gauche hardcopy-Scripture—with false faith in Jesus Christ who is invisible. Today, *if Jesus* is not on the page, the text is anecdotal. Christ spoke the verdict against contemporary Christianity, "For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for he wrote of Me" (John 5:46).

Seminary graduates are encouraged to prioritize relevance, banal bromides about Jesus, and entertainment worship. "<u>Every word</u> that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD (Deut. 8:3)" is contracted to the metonymy of "<u>Bible</u>" to feign commitment without examining the text.

Suddenly computers—much to the denial of every religious denomination—prove again and again when we have "<u>every word</u>" of Scripture. Computers expose the default academic mantra, "Only the nonextant original documents are the inspired and inerrant word of God," as a deception used by church bodies us manipulate religion and their membership.

The 16th Century Reformation maxim "by faith alone" has devolved into the denial of objective reality. The fictional right to self-affirming identity and personal truth is true if you believe it's true for you. Callous facts generated by computers analyzing the Hebrew and Greek text do not stimulate the euphoria of imaginary religion. Computers don't have souls, don't believe, and don't go to heaven so who cares what they reveal about the biblical text?

Once upon a time, there was this genius Rabbi from Florence Italy by the name of Umberto Cassuto—who fled to Jerusalem in 1938 and died there in 1951. Cassuto's name, books, and research are ignored by American academia. He discovered that the Torah contains *key words* and *key phrases* written in multiples of 7s, 10s, and 12s before the advent of computers. Cassuto's discovery has become a diagnostic tool for computer analysis to determine when we have the original text of the Bible. For example, a computer search for "The LORD God of

*Israel*" beginning with Moses, demonstrates the eternal God's revelation of Himself exactly 100 times in the *Tanakh* (Old Testament). We take Cassuto's discovery beginning with Moses through the Bible and we end the article with Moses.

The scholars of American religious denominations refuse to accept the results of textual analysis produced by machines. Jeremiah is an obvious focal point and adds "thus says" to "the LORD God of Israel" exactly 14 times (2 x 7). Notice how the Masoretes forgot to add Maqqefs (hyphens) at Jer. 25:15 and 33:4, which means they did not retro engineer the Tanakh. They had no idea they were preserving Hebraic Meter in the text.

Exactly seven of the above 100 phrases in the entire Bible add "et" (sign of an untranslatable direct object) to let readers know God wrote this book. According to American religious denominations, any claim that we have the original, inspired, inerrant words of Scripture is false doctrine. For example, President of the LCMS, Matthew Harrison, wrote: "The matter of the inerrancy of Holy Scripture is a matter of faith, not sight" (Lutheran Witness, 10/23/24). For Harrison only the original documents were empirical evidence, inspired, and inerrant, but are no longer visible, which defies rational thought. He confesses an invisible text to authenticate an invisible Jesus.

Jeremiah repeats "the house of Israel" exactly 20 times (2 x 10). Computers don't know this perfection is invisible. The only way for Church bodies to save American Christianity is with a sledgehammer.

Countless theologians "who have exceeded what is written" (1 Cor. 4:6), have made careers, collected salaries and pensions, and gained reputations by denying that we have the original written word of God. American denominationalism has turned "faith" into fantasy. Yet, Moses didn't need faith to see God at the burning bush, Israel didn't need faith to see God at the burning mountain, the Devil didn't need faith to talk to God in the desert, and no one needs faith to read a computer printout.

The militant Hebrew word *Hosts*, as in "the LORD of Hosts," "the Heavenly Hosts," or "the LORD of Armies," repeats in the Bible exactly 500 times. It would be a daunting task to catalogue all the Hebraic Meter associated with these 500 repetitions that do not rate doctrinal status. We offer a limited examination of Hebraic Meter associated with the word Hosts, such as "The LORD of Hosts"—which repeats in Jeremiah 72 times (6 x 12).

If the Masoretes had indeed retro-engineered the text in 1008 AD, they would not have neglected to add 13 *Maaqefs* (hyphens) to the above list, further proof they had no idea The Book of Jeremiah wrote with Moses' Hebraic Meter. As shown above, subsets in Hebraic Meter often exhibit a progression of complexity. "The LORD of Hosts" becomes "Thus says the LORD of Hosts," followed by a crescendo statement, "For thus says the LORD of Hosts," producing a new subset of 12 in the entire Bible. The interrelationship between these progressions displays a labyrinth of incomparable literary complexity. Here we also catch the Masoretes in another slip-

up with a *Maaqef* (hyphen) in Jeremiah 28:14. If they created the Meter, computer analysis reveals the Hebrew Bible is a fraud, and scriptural inspiration and inerrancy are mythology.

The transmutation of simple phrases set in Hebraic Meter is so subtle, without the aid of a computer readers are not aware of the literary tapestry woven into the text. It reads "*The LORD God of Hosts*" which then repeats exactly 12 times—six in the book of Amos and six not.

A related phrase "of the Hosts, the God of Israel, says, "Behold" appears exactly 10 times. Notice that the phrase contains words from three of the above examples and is found only in Jeremiah. Computers generate a cascade of data authenticating the Torah and the entire Bible.

Longer sets of seven appear as subsets within longer series of 40's, 50's, 60's, 70's and 100's. Also note that there are seven Hebrew words in each of the seven phrases, a phenomenon also found in Moses. Only Jeremiah places phrases like "for thus says," "the LORD of Hosts," and "the God of Israel" all together in one crescendo statement, and he does it seven times, which is the number of blessing or judgment/curse.

There is little if anything written about the distinction between the *written word of God* and the *spoken/heard word of God* on Earth. If it is written, it is heard, and if it is heard, it is written. The injunction is not to go beyond or ignore what is written (1 Cor. 4:6). To this point we read "*and the LORD Spoke*" exactly 100 times in 200 perfectly preserved words, beginning with Moses in Exodus 13:1 and ending in 2 Chronicles 33:10. This is not a hidden code. The Divine Style communicates that only God could have possibly written and preserved this text in preparation for the great and terrible day when there will be no excuse.

People ask, "How can a 3,500-year-old text possibly be relevant for me?" The fact is that it has taken mankind nearly 3,500 years to develop the technology just to begin unraveling its literary architecture. God communicates to all generations anticipating the context of their era, including the 21<sup>st</sup> Century techno-generation. The God of DNA is also the God of Scripture.

Themes centered on God's word permeate Scripture in Hebraic Meter. The phrase "the Word of the LORD" repeats 270 phrases beginning in Genesis 15:1 to Malachi 1:1 and is found in the first verse of at least 55 chapters, and the first verse of nine books in the Bible. In terms of Hebraic Meter, the series divides into 200 + 70 repetitions. To get a handle on this mountain of data, it will be limited to the 60 repetitions and related Hebraic Meter-subsets in Jeremiah.

The Masoretes failure to include at least 11 Maaqefs (hyphens) above indicates they had no idea they were preserving Hebraic Meter in the text.

In general, believers are not aware of the gravity with which God requires readers to know He wrote His book and that He commands/demands absolute agreement with everything He says. "Many are called but few are chosen" (Matt. 22:14). Untold populations live in His Creation without accountability to who made everything, why they are here, and what He requires. As He says, "they are without excuse" (Romans 1:20). This article increases their accountability, and some would be better off if they had never read what Jeremiah repeats here 10 times as follows.

The prophets speak as One writer calling readers to accountability, either to hear and obey God's Law ten times without infraction or to obey the *Law of faith* (Romans 3:27). Those who deny God's existence are destined to pray that they do not exist.

Forty-eight times in the Bible (4 x 12) Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and Zechariah write: "The word of the LORD came to me saying." This writer and many others believe the dictation theory, which means that the writers literally heard God and transcribed what He spoke to them in their own vernacular word-for-word. This theory is correct despite the profusion of denials from seminaries that the prophets and the apostles didn't hear word-for-word what they wrote down. Notice the repetition 48 times (4 x 12) in the Tanakh (Old Testament) where it states,

"And came to me the Word of the LORD saying." The flawless preservation of 240 words dismantles the delusion of religious denominationalism that inerrancy is invisible.

Changes in the arrangement of words in the above phrases can be so subtle they are hardly noticeable, such as the difference between "the word which came to Jeremiah" above and "and came the Word of the LORD to Jeremiah" twelve times below. Both contain the shorter phrase "to Jeremiah."

This is the genre of Divine communication, the Holy Spirit's genre of literary art. God didn't stop with a fragrant pistil and stamen, he also put rose petals around it.

Again, we ask, "What about the rest of the *Tanakh*?" The following 12 repetitions double the above repetition of "And came the Word of the LORD to" written by 10 additional prophets twelve times. Note that Hebrew word for "the prophet" in 1 Kings 13:20 הַּבָּרֵא repeats 120 times (12 x 10) in the Bible, but who has time to unravel all the complexity of this repetition?

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How does anyone explain this? Humanly speaking, all examples in this article with multiple authors (12 out of 35) exhibit a coordination beyond human capabilities—unless of course, the entire Hebrew Bible was edited and retro-engineered by one person. Yet, supporting evidence from the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Vulgate preclude this possibility. The Septuagint is far too paraphrastic for a reliable comparison. Either some editor unknown to the world retro-engineered the entire Bible—(including Daniel whom higher critics erroneously place at 164 BC)—or God wrote it. In either case, this genre itself is not comparable to any other writing of

Moses' era. When Israel returned to Caanan, they were surrounded by nations with similar languages but not similar literature.

Let's just throw in a few more examples from the cascade of computer data continues.

The symmetric spacing above divides in the middle into a vertical mirror image or linguistic Rorschach test with double sevens subsets, an example of the Holy Spirit's linguistic artistry. The following seventeen is a compound number comprised of seven and ten in Hebraic Meter. In this case the Meter is *gods/God* ten times and "*after other gods*" seven times. There are 17 down the middle of the Hebrew with seven on each side.

The text makes adjustments to maintain metered word order while preserving identical meaning. NASB translates all 40 repetitions above as "came to me the word of the LORD, saying" but 24:20 changes the word order. In fact, it is the only verse in the Bible with this word order. Rather than assume an error in the text at 24:20, in view of such obvious precision, we offer the theory that the alteration is designed to preserve order in an another overlapping linguistic matrix of Hebraic Meter. For example, the following phrase "came the word of the LORD to me saying" (הֵיָה דְּבַר־יִהְנָה אַלֵי לָאִמְר) appears in the Bible 55 times which is not Hebraic Meter. Yet, when the phrase "in the first of the month" is placed in front of seven repetitions, the 55 repetitions divides into the Hebraic Meter of 7 + 48 as exhibited below.

If the Jews were convinced that they were dealing with inexplicable intricacy in the Divine text, they would have treated the text as unalterable Holy ground. We really don't know how they understood the phrase, "the Word of the LORD." Today, Christians are careful to say we do not worship the Bible, but Roman Catholics, Orthodox, and even many Lutherans elevate the consecrated bread and wine for public adoration. The Jews on the other hand worshipped the text and continue to worship in the presence of their Torah scrolls, something which Christians frown as idolatry/bibliolatry. We read:

Moses placed the Torah in the Ark of the Covenant and worshipped the Ark, not as a box itself, but as the invisible God sitting on top of the box judging Israel on the basis of His words in the box. There may be no essential distinction between who God is and what God says. While we

translate God's words from one language to another, God translated Himself from human Words to Human flesh.

Similar to "the Word of the LORD" we find the same phrase "and the LORD spoke" in extended series of Hebraic Meter in the Torah (first five books of the Bible written by Moses). The phrase "And the LORD spoke to Moses saying," appears exactly 70 times (7 x 10) with 350 perfectly preserved words.

The above list is actually a subset of a much larger series based around דְבַר\*־יְהְהָּ ("\*the word\* of the LORD") with an asterisk placed on either side of the Hebrew \*word\*. This search produces 150 repetitions in the Torah, 270 repetitions outside the Torah, and 440 repetitions in the entire Tanakh (Old Testament). The two asterisks pull up all repetitions of "The Word of the LORD" and "and the LORD spoke." In terms of Hebraic Meter 150 = 100 +50, 270 = 200 + 70

and 440 = 400 + 40 or  $40 \times 10 + 4 \times 10$ . Make sure the vowel points are turned off for all of these searches. The writers of the Hebrew Bible never used vowel points; they spoke the vowels (whatever they were), but they did not write them.

There is no question that God used the Jews to preserve His words for the world. It is only fitting that He would use a Jew like Umberto Cassuto to continue the preservation of His word as He used the Masoretes. Jesus Christ's prophecy that not one jot or tittle would pass away from the Law (Matthew 5:18) continues to be fulfilled in these last days.

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Fourteen (2 x 7) of the above 30 repetitions have the addition "and you say to them." The intentionality required to preserve the meter in this list exposes the unseen Master-hand synchronizing the text similar to the precision required to order the human genome.
